The Glacier Falls Figure Skating Club Open Competition will be held October 3- 4, 2008 at Anaheim Ice Arena, 300 West Lincoln Avenue, Anaheim, CA 92805.

This competition is open to all U.S. Figure Skating Special Skating members and Special Olympic figure skaters. Two competitors comprise an event. All events will be conducted in accordance with the rules of the United States Figure Skating Association as set forth in its current Rulebook and Special Olympics as set forth in the Winter Sports Rules, except as herein provided.

#### JUDGING SYSTEM AND COMPUTATION FOR PLACEMENT

In all events the closed system of judging will be used and the number of judges shall be at least three (3). The decision of the Referee on all matters will be final. Items not specified in this announcement will be resolved by the Referee in accordance with the current Rulebook.

Computation for placement for all events shall be scored using the 6.0 system.

Decisions of the judges are not subject to protest, and shall be considered "field of play" decisions. However, errors discovered by the Chief Accountant prior to the posting of results are subject to correction prior to the posting of results. Computational errors are subject to correction prior to the award of medals.

For all free skating events, program content requirements will be in accordance with the current Rulebook unless otherwise noted in this announcement.

#### **AWARDS**

Large Medals will be awarded to first through fourth place winners. Smaller Medals will be awarded to fifth and above places. For events divided into groups there shall be no final rounds.

#### **ENTRY FEES**

Entries must be received no later than **SEPTEMBER 1, 2008**. Late entries will not be accepted.

Entry fees are refundable only if the competition is not held. In accordance with U.S. Figure Skating rules, entry fees shall not be refunded after the close of entries, **for any reason**, if two or more entries are received for an event.

#### **ICE ARENA**

Competition will be held at Anaheim Ice Arena, 300 West Lincoln Ave., Anaheim, CA 92805, on both the NHL Rink and Olympic Rink. The ice surface for the NHL Rink is approximately 85 by 200 feet, slightly rounded at the corners. The ice surface for the Olympic Rink is approximately 100 by 200 feet, slightly rounded at the corners. It is planned for the Special Skater events to be held on the Olympic Rink.

#### **DIRECTIONS TO ARENA**

From the 91 Fwy.: Exit at Harbor Blvd. Take Harbor Blvd. south to Lincoln Ave. Turn left onto Lincoln. Turn right at first stop light (about 1000 ft.) onto Clementine St. Turn left at first stop sign (about 600 ft.) and park in parking garage.

From the 5 Fwy.: Exit at Lincoln Ave. Take Lincoln east. After reaching Harbor Blvd. continue straight ahead. Turn right at next stop light (about 1000 ft.) onto Clementine St. Turn left at first stop sign (about 600 ft.) and park in parking garage.

#### PRACTICE ICE

No official practice ice will be offered. Unofficial practice ice will be offered through the competition committee, if available ice time permits. Final details for scheduling practice ice will be made available on the club's web site after the close of entries.

#### **SCHEDULE OF EVENTS**

An Official Schedule of Events will be posted at Anaheim Ice Arena. and on the SWP official website, <a href="https://www.2009SWP.com">www.2009SWP.com</a>. Schedules will not be mailed to individual entrants. This schedule is subject to change. Any changes will be posted on the Official Bulletin Board at the Anaheim Ice Arena and on the GFFSC web site. Do not call Anaheim Ice Arena for specific competition information. Direct all competition inquiries to one of the people listed in this announcement.

#### REGISTRATION DESK

The Registration Desk will be located in the entrance area to the NHL Rink of Anaheim Ice Arena and will be open each day of the competition beginning one hour prior to the first event through the end of the last event. All competitors are required to register one hour prior to their scheduled events.

#### **MUSIC**

Music must be turned in at the time of registration for the competition. All music must be labeled with the competitor's name, the specific event and the exact running time of the music. Media not so labeled will not be accepted. All music must be picked up at the completion of each event. Music will not be returned through the mail or by other means. All competitors must have one backup CD readily available at the time they skate.

Only CD-R media will be accepted. However, due to compatibility problems as well as unreliability, CD-RW media will not be accepted.

#### **BADGES**

At the time of registration, each competitor will receive a badge. Each competitor may request one (1) chaperone badge and one (1) professional badge which will be issued at no charge. One additional professional badge may be purchased for \$35. Badges will entitle the chaperones and the professionals to admission to backstage areas of the competition. No chaperone or professional badge will be issued unless their names are listed on the Entry Form. To be credentialed all professionals must be members of U.S. Figure Skating and have completed all USFSA professional requirements. No exceptions will be made.

#### **ADMISSIONS**

Admission will be charged for all events. General Admission is \$10 each day. An all event pass may be purchased for \$35. Children who have not yet reached their seventh birthday are admitted free.

#### VIDEO TAPING AND/OR PHOTOGRAPHY

Commercial video and commercial still photography will be provided. No video taping, other than by the official videographer is allowed or authorized by USFSA or Glacier Falls FSC, Inc.. All other photography is restricted to hand held battery operated equipment, without tripod. No photography, except by the official photographer, without the express permission of the person being photographed is allowed. Photography or video taping for any commercial purpose is strictly prohibited. Flash photography is prohibited at all times during the completion.

#### **DIVISION OF GROUPS**

If there are more than eighteen (18) entries in any one class of an event, the skaters in that class shall be divided into groups of no more than eighteen (18) skaters to be drawn by lot. There will be no final rounds.

#### **JUMP RESTRICTIONS**

Jump requirements for all programs in all events will conform to the requirements in the current Rulebook, unless explicitly stated otherwise in this announcement.

The competition venue is 3 miles north of Disneyland. Accommodations of all pricing levels and star ratings are available, at nearby hotels, most of which are within five to ten minutes by car from the Anaheim Ice Arena. No transportation will be provided by the LOC from hotels to the arena.

#### SPECIAL SKATER FREE SKATING EVENTS

Special Skater Free Skate events are open to any skater with a disability, including mental and physical challenges. Please note any special limitations of the skater, such as hearing or vision impairment, as well as any other physical challenges that would require special consideration (such as special equipment like walkers) and include it with the entry form.

All Special Skater Free Skating events will be skated on the full ice of the arena in accordance with Section E of the Special Olympics Winter Sports Rules, published 2003.

All Special Skater Free Skating Programs must conform to the well balanced program requirements for the 2008/09 season.

All Special Skater Free Skating events shall be judged using the 6.0 system.

#### Special Skaters may enter two or more free skating events at different levels.

The Special Skater Free Skate programs will be skated to instrumental or vocal music. Artistic programs permitted.
